SOME MAGAZINES AND STUFF.

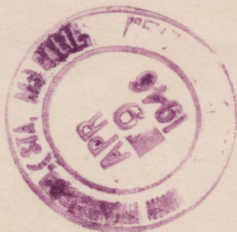


How's Bob getting along with his
