Just finished my lunch.

I received two packages from you yesterday. Boy, they're sure coming in. I had two cartons of cigarettes, magazines, a box of candy, two sausages (everyone was surprised) and some tuckernose. Thanks very much. For holding the cigarettes till I go to Florence again. I received a letter from you this morning. Oh, yes, one of the packages had a article in the magazines about the Nazis in the Pacific. Not a good article.

It's raining again today. Boy, I'm sure tired of their rain. It wouldn't be so bad if it was just Lome.

Well, I've been in the Army a long time now and, by golly, I'm homesick for the first time. With everybody talking about going home (especially these days that come over only about three months ago)

I want to go home too. In a hurry.
The dog I have is getting to be pretty
spoiled. It's a cute dog so everyone grabs
her and it soon went to her head.
I'd like to bring her home with me but
I'll have to think it over.

more tomorrow
