Dear Mom and Pop,

Not much doing today. I'm watching the phone today. We take turns at watching the phone.

The weather is getting bad again. I thought that spring was here, but it seems that we didn't get rid of the bad weather yet; I think it'll clear up this afternoon.

I received two first class packages from you yesterday. It had two pairs of wool socks in it. Thanks very much. I can always use good socks. Your letters are coming in regularly now days, so I hope that my letters are coming in, too.

The tea set is all ready to send out. I wrote the name down last night and so all I have to do is to mail it out.

I think that the other package I sent you should be getting there pretty soon. It has two wooden boxes in there. I put a Zeppo lighter in the box for To-chan. I had it covered with leather in Florence when I went down. There's some pictures for you, too. I put a small figure made out of metal that I picked up in Cortina. You should be getting the package by the time this letter reaches you.

Every time I go down to Florence, I see more different things that I want. The last time I went down, I saw a imported Dresden China set that was really beautiful... it's from Germany. Maybe I'll buy it. I don't know yet.

I just received a letter from you. It was written on the 16th of March so it reached here pretty fast. You don't seem to get my letters very fast, do you?

Terry went to Switzerland about a week ago so his assistants are taking care of the regimental paper. You know that Tak Yatabe worked in the same department with him..Terry took over when Mike Masaoka and Doc and the rest went home. There's a boy from Ogden working there, too. His name is Ryo Uchida. They call me the extra man of PRO because I hang around there so much.

I guess Bob and Tak are pretty well settled by now. How is Bob getting along with his new job?

I'm writing another request. I hope I'm not sending you too many requests.
