Well, here it is Easter Sunday. I was going to Florence this morning but I decided not to go because it's kind of cold today.

I received two letters from you yesterday. Your letters are coming in pretty regularly these days. I hope you're getting mine's too.

The other day I met some of my old buddies I trained with in Florida. I haven't seen them in a long time so we had a lot of fun talking about the old times. I haven't John lately. I'll have to go see him at his company.

We're having Easter church services outdoors today. We usually have in the club house but because today is such a important day we decided to have it outside.

The post man just came in. I don't have any letters from you today. I'll probably get some tomorrow.

Not much goes on around here. Things are getting pretty boring. The Army life is getting strict here too. Now that the war is over the officers expect the soldiers to conduct themselves more neatly. We have to keep our tents and things neat and just so like we use to in basic training. We have a lot of inspections of this and that quit often now.
