We got our sun tens the other day. It's our summer uniform.

Boy, do me a favor. If you can send it by first class mail send me a sun ten shirt. Don't get the regular kind just get a

thin material shirt. You know what
kind I mean, don't you. The material
is thinner than the GI issue.

See if you can send it by first class
mail. The size is 15 collar and
32 sleeve. Make the sleeve a half
in or so shorter with you.

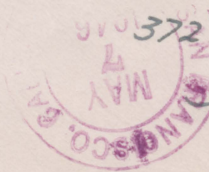
