of the boys are getting it like  
that.

I think I may go up to Germany  
to go to a Information + Education  
Section School. You know Jim the  
I+E man for this company. Well,  
I might or then again, I may not.  
I'll be for one week.

Well, if I don't go I told the  
captain already that I'd like to  
go & come next month. I told him  
I need a week vacation because  
I'm working too hard ???

well, I hope you can find a  
job after you leave the Heathys.  
It's best to get settled down as soon  
as possible. Working in a family  
isn't such a hot idea because  
of the irregular hours. In some  
everything will go OK.
