Oct 10, 1944

Dear Mom and Pop,

Boy, oh boy, oh boy! I got paid tonight. I got \$47.20. That's with insurance deduction.

We were out all day today again at the rifle range. We fired from the 300 yard line instead of the 200 yard range.

I didn't get a letter from you today, so I'll probably get it the next day.

I saved some of the shells (quite empty) I fired today. If you think Freddy or Tommy would like to have the 30 caliber shells, I'll send them to him. Let me know.

I received a letter from Aunt Tomi a couple of days ago. I don't remember if I told you or not. I also got a school paper from Frank Okazaki yesterday. I don't have much time this week because we're out all day but from next week, it'll be a little better.

I'll cut this letter short tonight. You'll have to excuse me just for this week for writing short letters. Next week, I'll have more time to write.
