Dear Mom and Pop,

I received three letters from you today.

I've been very busy these past few days. Didn't have much time for myself. Today was the last day for my work. I've been clearing up the files and records for Special Service and I and E material.

I think the regiment will leave for the staging area around the 15 or 19 of this month. From there, the men who isn't going home will be placed in different

units and those going home will
wait for the ships. I'm hoping
Ryo's and my orders come before
Sevaco Company moves down. This
means we'll have to move two
times. In case you don't know
it yet, Ryo Uchida and I are
going to American Graves Registration
Unit about 30 miles from Florence

Start writing here after I tell
you I'm leaving. I'll let you
know when I go.

We're just waiting for the orders
to come in. The PBS Command
OK'd it and there's a letter in
Rome at present which will be
signed and then we'll be at
GRCU. I know that a lot
of the boys want to get in
there, too. It's a good job and the
pay is good too. Well, I'll be
there only a very short time and
then I'll go home so it's not
too much difference.

I sent you some pictures that
Jimmy gave me of the regiment.

I'll reach you soon.
