for Castel Fiorentino. This is the American  
Cemetery this is our station. It's about  
30 miles from Florence. It's a beautiful  
place.

Say, I told Jerry that he can  
use our home address so that  
when he gets mail in Italy it will  
be waiting for him at San Francisco Is  
that OK? He'll drop around  
there in a couple of months.

Maybe early part of August. If he  
gets any letters send it for him  
will you? He's going back to Hawaii  
as soon as the regiment deactivates  
in the States.

We just came back from the  
movies tonight. We saw  
"Well Groomed Bride". It was  
a very good picture.

Today, I was driving around  
on the 2½ ton truck. It's not  
too hard to drive a big truck  
like that. It's a lot of fun.  
We just went riding all over.

Well, this is about all for  
today so when I get up to  
GRU I'll let you know. That's  
tomorrow night.

until I say so.
