I think we'll be going on a
trip next week sometime. We have
a small truck to ourselves. I hear
that when we go out on field work
we get \$5 a day extra.

There's only 20 men out here so
we really love it here. There's one
lieutenant, one sergeant and only one T/S.
All the rest are PFC's and PVT's. We're
the only two that come in with ratings.
The officer told us today that when we
go out we're to be in charge.

That's a big laugh. We don't know
what to do yet.

The mess hall here is really something.
Just like back home. Italian workers serve
us and we don't have to buy our mess
kits or anything. We have very good
chow here, too.

We have no guards, no KP, no CP
or anything. We really have a nice
jot.

Well, this is about all for today

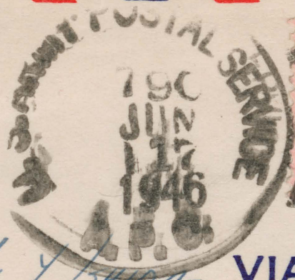
