I received four letters and a package from you last night. The package had a carton of cigarettes, a box of peacan candy and magazines. Thanks very much. The other stuff should be coming in soon because a ship came in with lots of mail.

I saw in July 22's Time a article about the 442. Jerry's name was in the article, too!

I told you not to send packages
but I guess it won't hurt to
send a couple more. I'll write a
request later.
