Your letters are coming in regularly. Your packages are pretty good.

Henry Zukin came out to the cemetery this morning. He came to see some of our fellows that were killed in Italy. We all ask the same question when we see some folk. When do we go home? Well, it won't be too long now.

We don't get newspapers out here so we don't know too much what's happening in the outside world.

How's things back home? Still having a hard time buying things, I bet.

All I'm hoping is I hope
we can get a car when or
by the time I come home.
I see it's pretty hard even to
get a second hand car that's in
good condition.

The weather has been pretty
hot the past week. We just sleep
with a sheet over us. No
flannels,

well, this is about all for
today or more ~~tomorrow~~
