We just came back from the movies. We have only one minute - oh - the whistle just blew for lights out.

well, I'll write you tomorrow

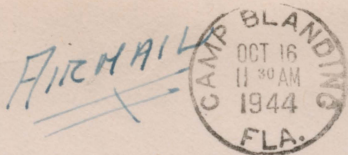
