because Saturday we'll be out all day
again. I think we're going to fire those
bazookas we have been hearing so
much about. I think you know what they are.
Ask Tomi.

We're going to the service club tonight
so I'll write more when I get back.

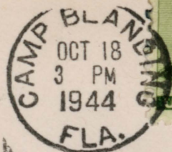
