Oct 29, 1944

Dear Mom and Pop,

I received two of your letters. One was this noon and one tonight.

We went out to the rifle range again today. We stayed there all day. We had squad rifle fire today. The squad leader (me) tells his men what the distance is, what the target is and how to scatter the shot.

I didn't send the shells to the kids yet. You see, the mail clerk is sick and can't bring packages out to the post office. We have to bring out our own packages, and the post office is pretty far. I hope the kids can wait a little while. I'll send it the first chance I get.

I hope that you received my book by now. I know you'll enjoy it. Right now John is building a fire in the stove. It get a little cold in the mornings and nights but during noon it's just right. I'll make this letter short and will write more tomorrow
