I also received a letter from you today too. It had some stamps in them. Thanks again. By the way, sending the funnies with the cookies was a swell idea. I appreciate them. We have the same funnies but some of the sections are different.

You asked me what I wanted for Christmas. Well, since I'm in the Army, my wants are very few and simple. I can't think of anything I want, but I think I can use a pair of pants. The

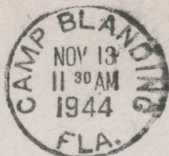
