This is the first chance I had to write to you today. I've been a busy little man today. We had our first fall day. We did marching exercises, and went to various educational movies.

I hope I'm not putting you into too much trouble by asking to you send me various things. I'm going to ask you again to send me something. I'd like to have a couple of clothes hangers and pants hangers. They were all sold out at the PX and we tried to go to the main PX, but it was too far. It's about two hours from our canteen. This gives you a idea of the size of our camp. It would take all day to walk from one end of the camp to the other, maybe more.

I'm expecting to get some mail from you tomorrow or day after tomorrow. That is if you answered me right away.

I just ate my supper and I guess I'll go to the PX and get a coke or something with John and Tad.

I don't what to write to you a lot so in your next letter I tell me what you what to know, and I'll tell you in the next letter.
