We didn't do very much tonight. We had dinner at the service club and then we went to the library to read some magazines.

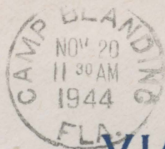
I missed mail call today so I didn't get your letter. I'll get it tomorrow.
