Wednesday 6:30 PM Nov 29, 1944

Dear Mom and Pop,

I really hit the jackpot today. I received four of your letters today. We came home last night around 4:00 AM. I got up at 11:00 AM this morning. All day yesterday and last night we had different types of tactics. Our company attacked Company C (Nesic) and we won. Our squad managed to get through their lines without them knowing it. We finished around 1:00 AM and we then started out for home. We were 5 miles out and so we were given compass readings. We had to come home by compass and without light. Boy, I was worried we'd get off our course but we made it home all right.

Tonight four men and myself have

to go out to the range as range guards.
We have to sleep out there over night to
guard the range that we're using tomorrow.
I'm supposed to be in charge.
We're going to have a nice time.

8:30 PM

Boy, we don't have to go on guard tonight.
The truck we were supposed to use was
detained elsewhere so we're not going out.
The rest of the company is out on guard
tonight so I'm the only one in our hut. Out
of the whole company, four men and
myself are free tonight. Pretty good, eh?
I just took a hot shower and am
now in bed writing this letter.

You said that you forgot John's name.
Well, just to remind you again, it's
John Miyasaki. I'll give him his
Christmas present on the 24th night.

I'm sorry to hear that Mr. Okawachi passed away. If you see Toru again, tell him I said hello and give him my sympathies.

I haven't very much to write now so I'll write again tomorrow

P.S. By the way, in about two weeks we'll be going on a two week bivouac (pronounced biv-wac.) That's a two week camping trip. We'll be sleeping in tents for two weeks. I can probably write letters to you, so I'll write to you from out in the fields. I'll tell you all about it. This is the final test of our company.
