Dear Mom and Pop,

I received your letter of Monday. I'm glad to hear that you got the shells I sent. I have one 50 caliber shell and also a slug so one of these days I'll send it. It's really a big thing.

Today we went to the rifle and automatic rifle range. We had a lot of fun firing the rifles, only we sure had a time cleaning them tonight.

We had ~~an~~ speed march out to the range today. Speed march is when you run or trot for two minutes and then walk for one minute. We did this for one hour and we covered 5 miles. This is pretty good - 5 miles in one hour.

I don't have much to write today so I'll write to you again tomorrow.

By the way, will you send me my wool scarf? It's getting cold.
