Dec 8, 1944

Dear Mom and Pop,

We sure had a busy day today. We got up at 5:30 AM and left for the fields at 7:00 AM. We worked on squad tactics all day and came home at 8:00 PM. We then cleaned our rifles until 10:00 PM, and then we cleaned up.

I just finished and am now writing. We have rifle inspection tomorrow.

Well, we're leaving for bivouac on Monday morning at 3:00 AM.

We'll be back around the 22nd.

As soon as I come back from Bivouac I'll send a telegram to you to send me some money. I'll need a little money for train fare to get home on my furlough. It'll probably be around \$60.

I received your letter of Monday and also the stamps you sent. Thanks very much. By the way, if there is a nice sleeveless sweater I sure can use it.

When I get the furlough ~~it~~ it'll probably be around the middle of January. We all ready had to sign our place of destination today.

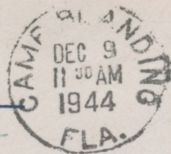
