Dec 16, 1944

Dear Mom and Pop,

We came in late last night (12:00) so we have a half a day again today. We're moving out of our camping area to another place about a mile down. We are going to leave at 1:30 PM today.

Out at the field yesterday, the mail clerk brought me two of your letters.

You asked if you should send Grandpa one of my pictures. Please do. I didn't have the material to send it to him so I sent it all to you. Pick one and send it to him.

My photographs should be ready by now. I told the mail clerk not to bring it out here but to hold it until I come back. I'll mail it to you as soon as I get back. We have only one more week to go, you know.

Last night company "C" attacked our company but they couldn't get through our line of defense, so technically we won.

I'm going down to the lake in a minute to wash up. There's a big lake only 50 yards or so away from us. It looks something like Lake Tahoe. It's really a nice looking place but it sure gets cold in the mornings.

As I look around, every body is busy packing. I finished packing so I don't have much to do.
