
Dear Sir:

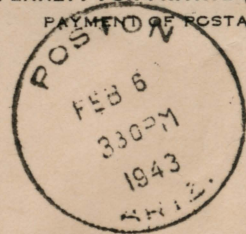
