

Army to Give Up Tule Lake Control

TULELAKE, Calif., Jan. 12. — Reliable sources inside the Tule Lake Japanese Segregation Center said today the Army will relinquish its control and administration of the camp to the War Relocation Authority.

An employe who holds a responsible position in the center said the Army will withdraw from the camp proper and station a "perimeter guard" about the inclosure.

Transfer of administration of the camp reportedly was scheduled for today, but it was not learned immediately whether the W. R. A. actually had taken charge again.
