nized in Spokane. Frederick Elkington, a Seattle overseer of the University Friends Meeting, of which the bride and bridegroom are members, read the Statement of Friends. The couple made their vows and exchanged

rings. Both attended the University of Washington. Hirabayashi carried his test suit unsuccessfully to the United States Supreme Court, and last month was arrested here on a charge of failing to fill out and return a Selective Service question-He is at liberty under bond of \$1,000. He will appear before a Seattle judge at an unspecified future date.

After a brief wedding trip the Hirabayashis will make their home

here.
