

Exclusion of Aliens Urged

WAPATO, July 25.—(AP)—Formulation of legal measures by the United States attorney-general for "the removal of dangerous enemy aliens from the nation as speedily as war conditions will permit was asked yesterday in a resolution adopted by the "Remember Pearl Harbor League" here. "Various selfish and sentimental" interests have aided and encouraged return and infiltration of Japanese enemy aliens into the Yakima Valley, the resolution said.
