DEFENSE ENDS ITS TESTIMONY IN THAW CASE

Doctors and Nurse From Europe Tell of the Irrational Way in Which Prisoner Acted Abroad.

LONG QUESTION PUT TO MEDICAL EXPERTS

Attorney for Accused Millionaire Reviews All Evidence in Trial in an Interrogatory of 15,000 Words.

NEW YORK, Monday, Jan. 27.—The defense in the Thaw case completed today the introduction of all its testimony. Thaw's chief counsel for the defendant, began to read a long and carefully prepared hypothetical question to the three alienist engaged to testify in Harry K. Thaw's behalf.

As the testimony in the present hearing has been completed before the first trial, so the hypothetical question differed from the one propounded last year by the defense. The evidence as to irrational acts of Thaw, from infancy to the time of the homicide, was taken from every other phase of the testimony.
