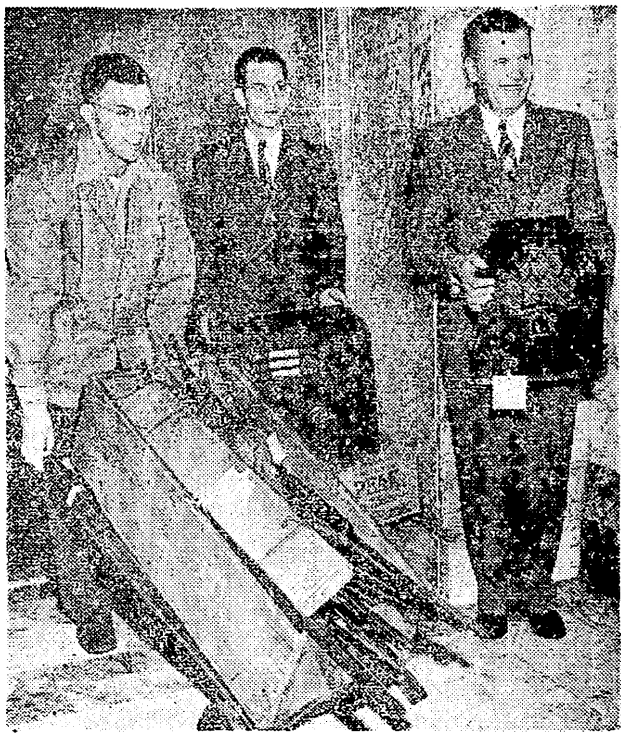


JAPANESE RIFLES
