

JAPAN DAY AT PARK TOMORROW

Oriental Will Participate in Program of Addresses and Vocal Music at Kinnear Community Gathering.

TOMORROW will be known as "Japan Day" at the regular Sunday community gathering at Kinnear Park, and several Orientals will be prominent on the program as speakers and vocalists. T.
