SAN FRANCISCO COAST RANGES TO OCEAN

Famous Railroad Builder, in San Francisco Speech, Advocates Swiss Military System in Schools.

SAN FRANCISCO, Saturday, Oct. 21.—Adoption by the states of Washington, Oregon and California of the Swiss military system in the public schools, and the construction of two great highways from Canada to Mexico, one to be built by the government and the other by the three states, were advocated in an address here today before the San Francisco Commercial Club by Samuel Hill of Maryland.

Hill, who is widely known as a railroad builder and good roads advocate, recently returned from Europe, where he went at the request of the Russian government to suggest plans for increasing the transportation facilities of the transiberian railroad.

Should Act at Once. "I ask that you argue in these three Coast states," he said, "the importance of not waiting for action by the national government, but that these states should resolve to install and install immediately in all schools in the several states, both for men and women alike, between the ages of 16 and 21, such training as the Swiss military system, as will make the men and women capable of sharing and bearing their part in time of peace and war."

From there he routed the highway along a southwest course, through the Pitt River country, which he said was without scenic parallel, into the Siskiyou Valley, which would be the highway system of interior California.

That is the only way, Hill asserted, "that any day in the future 100,000 people of California can be connected with the same number of people living in Oregon and Washington."

And I want to speak to you about another matter equally applicable to the region covered by the highway, and that is the Ocean Highway, which California, Oregon and Washington should unite in making the most important element to build, as near as may be to the ocean, a highway which shall run from the Columbia River to the mouth of the San Francisco Bay.
