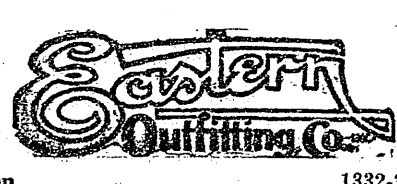

NO TRAINS MOVING AT LOS ANGELES

Railroad Strikers in Southern California Have Not Decided on Action.

CONFERENCES ARE HELD

By Associated Press. LOS ANGELES, Cal., Friday, Aug. 22.—Railroad strikers, to receive them on former terms of employment and brotherhood heads working toward the resumption of their duties, all awaited action by the men themselves today. In the meantime, the striking of steam roads here continued complete. Engines popping steam coupled to long trains of cars at every depot, while behind the barriers stood hundreds of travelers eager to resume their interrupted journeys or start on long-delayed trips, but not a single complete crew reported to any point here.
