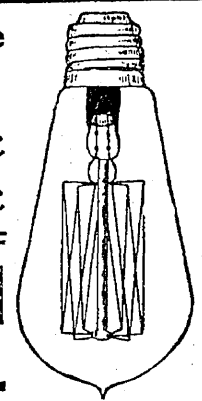

KING OF APPLES HAS PICTURE TAKEN

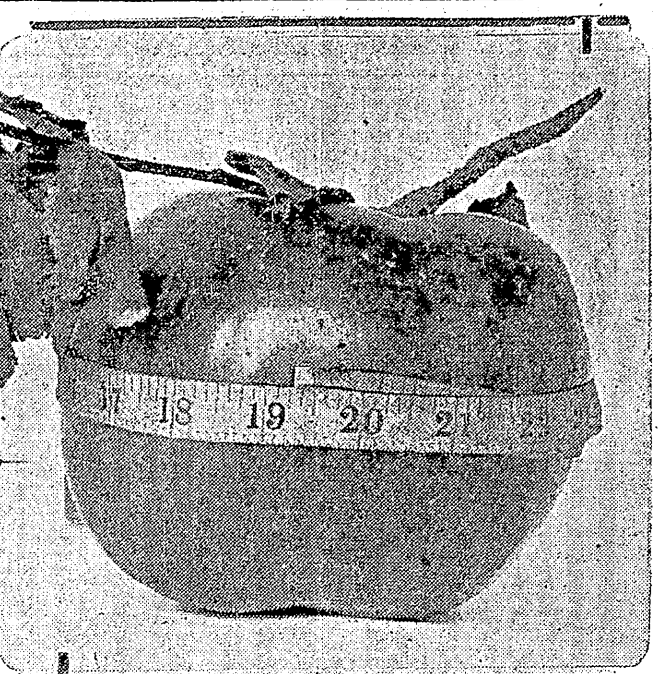

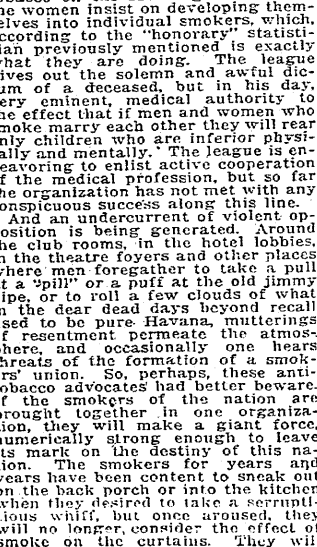
