SIR SAM HUGHES DEAD

Issaquah Mine Operating and Newcastle Will Soon Be Declared Local Officers. Although operating companies reported today further progress in obtaining men to reopen the Western Washington coal mines that were closed by a strike of 2,800 members of the United Mine Workers more than five months ago, shipments of coal to the Seattle and Tacoma markets have not yet begun.

Strike leaders at the headquarters of the United Mine Workers in Seattle said today that their reports from all camps where the operators are attempting to reopen the mines were that few real miners had been shipped in and that there was no sign of weakening in the union ranks.

Advisory Groups May Assist Conference. WASHINGTON, Wednesday, Aug. 24.—President Harding has under consideration the formation of advisory groups to assist the United States delegation to the disarmament conference which meets in Washington in November.

Nansen Rebuffed By Hoover Representative. RIGA, Wednesday, Aug. 24.—Fridtjof Nansen, the famous Arctic explorer, representing the International Red Cross, telegraphed Gustav Ador, president of Switzerland and of the International Red Cross, that his negotiations with Walter Lyman Brown for cooperation in relieving the Russian famine sufferers have failed and that should Herbert Hoover in answer to Mr. Brown's cable for instructions refuse cooperation he (Nansen) will resign immediately upon his return from Moscow on Thursday.
