JAPANESE AGAIN IS ARRESTED IN HOTEL FIRE QUIZ

Oriental Cannery Worker, Friend of Woman Proprietor, Jailed After Jury Hears Evidence of Arson

Arrested for the second time in connection with the Portland Hotel fire of October 17, S. Takayama, a Japanese cannery worker, was locked up in the city jail this morning and held for the coroner's jury which is investigating the tragedy.

Detective Chief Charles Tennant said Takayama was rearrested at the request of Coroner William J. Jones. Takayama, Chief Tennant said, was a friend of Mrs. Tomo Mayeda, Japanese proprietor of the Portland Hotel, and has visited her at a hospital where she was taken when she received injuries in an attempt to jump to safety. Ten men lost their lives and thirteen others were injured.

Jury Investigates.

Takayama was arrested last Saturday and released after questioning. But after the coroner's jury had listened all day yesterday to evidence which seemed to prove beyond doubt that the fire was of incendiary origin and possibly prompted by revenge, Coroner Jones asked that he be apprehended again and held until the jury resumes its deliberations November 1.

He strongly protested his innocence when he was arrested by Detectives Joseph Blanche and W. N. Miller at Sixth Avenue and Main Street. He had a check for \$800 and \$252.85 in cash.

DOG WINS FIGHT FOR LIFE; CAT'S FATE LEFT TO COURT

ROXY, 5-year-old pet collie, was saved from a trip to dog heaven today by Justice of the Peace John B. Wright, who nevertheless ordered the collie kept in his master's yard, "even if he has to be tied."

Roxy lives in West Seattle, with his master, William R. Buckley, at 2622 47th Ave. S. W. Next door lives A. L. Carter, photographer.

Carter, in Justice Wright's Court, charged that Roxy was a vicious dog, penalty for which is death for the dog or \$100 fine for the owner.

Justice Wright this forenoon decided that Roxy was not so much to blame as the human being who brought him into court. The justice told the warring neighbors that they should try to acquire some human kindness and try to settle their differences without picking on the dog.

The case, it was decided, was the result of a neighborhood quarrel.

The neighborhood was equally divided on the subject of Roxy's viciousness and one or two testified that the Carters had been very fond of Roxy prior to the time they had their quarrel with the Bucleys.

THE Superior Court this afternoon was to be the legal battleground in the settlement of the estate of Mrs. Elizabeth Stoops or Adams, who died October 11, leaving a will requesting her executor, C. W. Johnson, to take the life of her cat, Tommy.

Acquaintances of the elderly woman, who learned of the existence of the will shortly after her death, informed Superior Judge Smith that she believed her soul would unite with the soul of her cat in the hereafter.

The admittance to probate of the will is being opposed by Attorney Arthur Hutchinson, counsel for Miss Blanche Hutchinson, a friend of Mrs. Stoops, who was appointed special administratrix of the estate by Judge Smith before the existence of the will was known.

In a trial brief submitted yesterday to Judge Smith, Attorney Hutchinson says:

"By the civil law, where a person writes a will in his own favor, the instrument is rendered void, and in modern times the courts still view such conduct with disfavor."

PROPERTY WILL BE SOLD TO PAY TAXES

Millions of Dollars Worth of Holdings to Go on Auction Tomorrow Morning.

A million dollars worth of property on which taxes have been delinquent for five years will be sold tomorrow by the county treasurer in the first floor corridor of the King County City Building at 9 o'clock tomorrow morning.

Kills 200,000,000 germs in 15 seconds

Fourteen Executed As Czarist Plotters In Russian Province

ROSTOVON DON, Russia, Friday, Oct. 25.—Fourteen Russians, including two former high officers of the Army and three counter-revolutionists, were executed here today for subversive activities against the government, robbing the countryside and terrorizing the population.

A large number of others identified with the organization were sent at the same time to concentration prison camps and sentences of hard labor for from five to ten years. Individual peasants who were drawn into the circle through ignorance were liberated.

Authorities said the members formed themselves into a militant Czarist organization which operated under the guise of a religious sect named "Imyaslavtzi."

Bellingham Matron Ends Life at Home Of Relative Here

BELIEVED dependent over domestic troubles, Mrs. Lota Pugh, 38-year-old Bellingham matron, committed suicide this forenoon by firing a bullet into her temple at the home of a relative, Fred Phillips, 418 Tenth Ave. W.

TUTTLE GIRL DENIES CHARGES OF MOTHER

Daughter Says She Was Not Detained Against Will, as Injured Parent Feared.

Such a surmise on the part of her mother, Mrs. Helen Tuttle, Seattle nurse, 1023 Spruce St., was fully taken, the daughter said.

The girl is under \$1,500 bond as a material witness against George Wilson, with whom she was arrested in a narcotics raid at 2511 Yale Ave. N., a short time ago. She has been in daily communication with her mother since her release, she said, and arranged for the room at the Virginia Mason Hospital, where her mother is recovering from a purported attack last Monday.

The mother told police she had been stabbed with a hypodermic needle by an assailant whom she believed belonged to a narcotics gang which was detaining her daughter.
