ROZA IRRIGATION PROJECT WILL BE STARTED IN 1933

United States Commissioner of Reclamation Files Plans for Yakima River Development With State.

OLYMPIA, Tuesday, March 25.—Bearing the approval of Dr. Elwood Mead, United States Commissioner of the Bureau of Reclamation, a report revealing for the first time the accepted plans for the development, at a cost of \$12,000,000, of the federal government's next big reclamation project in Washington State, yesterday was placed on file with Eric S. Barnes, director of agriculture and of the Department of Conservation and Development.

The new project, known as the Roza division of the Yakima River watershed development, includes 66,000 acres of arid land extending from Moxee City, a few miles southeast of Yakima to a point near Benton City in Benton County.

Construction Starts in 1933. Construction work, the report said, will begin in 1933, the year after the completion of the Kittitas Division, which is scheduled for the summer of 1932.

Recommendations in the report represent the conclusions of a special board of engineers and economists which was organized by Mead at the request of Commissioner Mead. The findings of the board were withheld from publication until after they had been reviewed, and approved by the bureau.

The board ruled against proposals involving the joint construction of the Roza and Kennewick divisions of the Yakima project but recommended that construction of the Kennewick unit be undertaken after the Roza unit is completed.

Board Recommendations Approved. The recommendations of the board as approved by Commissioner Mead are: 1.—That the construction of the Roza division begin as soon as funds are available, considering the requirements of the Cle Elum reservoir, for which \$10,000,000 has already been appropriated.

2.—That the estimated cost of improvements in connection with the highlands at Kennewick is \$450,000 and includes 4,000 acres, of which 2,600 is now in a highly developed state of cultivation.
