SLUGGING GAME, NIPPON BEATEN

Gaffney Leads Madrona to Victory Over University; Gaw Closed Season With .500 Average.



POTTING the Queen Anne tossers to a 7-to-2 lead in the third inning, Ballard piled up enough runs in the next four frames to stand up under a late rally by the Hilltoppers and win, 13 to 12. The game was one of three closing Community League contests.

Johnny Gaffney, with a pair of triples and a single in four attempts, led Madrona to a 12-to-5 victory over University. Wilson Gaw hit two out of four to finish the season with a .500 batting average. George Hurley and Rumpy Seymour also did well with the stick for the Madacs.

Greenwood-Phinney pulled an upset over the Nippon A. C. nine, winning 12 to 5. Clarence Pautzke and Helnie Bendele led the Greenwood hitters, Pautzke getting a triple and two singles and Bendele a homer. Dalzel also bagged a home run.
