

# Japanese And Chinese Won't Play Football

SAN FRANCISCO, Monday, Jan. 7.—Japan and China, as represented by San Francisco's Oriental colonies, have severed athletic relations.

The break was disclosed today with announcement the annual Japanese-Chinese football game is definitely off.
