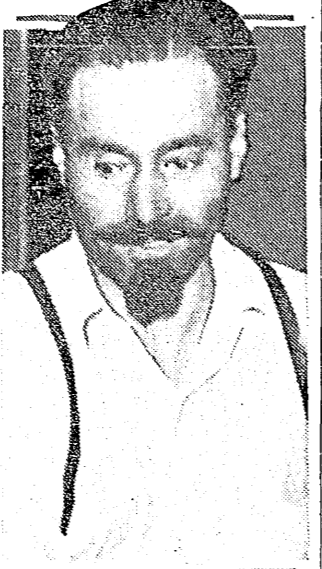
GUILD STRIKE IN 26TH DAY
