IS FORUM TOPIC

Two Seattle Chinese and two Japanese will join Dr. Norman F. Coleman, public forum leader, in a discussion of the question "Why Japan Breaks Treaties" at 8 o'clock Tuesday night at John Marshall Junior High School, Miss. Elvina Miller, forum director, announced yesterday.

The Japanese taking part will be Attorney Thomas Matsuda and Henry S. Tatsumi, instructor in Oriental studies department at the University of Washington. The Chinese who will speak are C. K. Cheng and Lawrence Kay, both graduates of the University. Kay also is a graduate of Yen King University at Peking and recently returned from the Orient.
