PUGET POWER SEIZURE URGED

The Puget Sound Public Utility District Commissioners Association today asked President Roosevelt and Secretary of Interior Harold Ickes to take over the properties of the Puget Sound Power & Light Company immediately and combine this system with a vast network comprising both the Bonneville and Grand Coulee plants.

A. G. Ziebel, chairman of the negotiating committee of the association, sent telegrams to the President and Ickes in which he said the step is necessary in the national defense program.

Ziebel said the property should be taken over regardless of all present plans for purchase because the purchase plans are such that it would be some time before the property could be acquired.

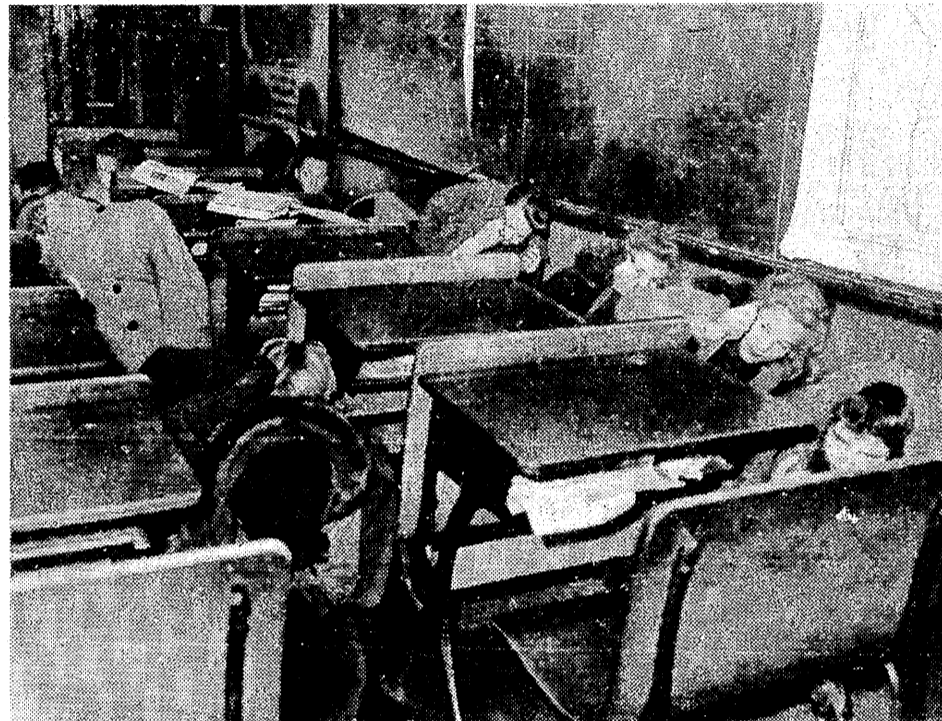

Cascade School Pupils Hold First Air-Raid Warning Drill

Orderly, soberly responding to the first intensive air-raid drill executed at the Cascade School, 520 children this forenoon vacated classrooms and stationed themselves in the first-floor hall and basement of the school building.

Eighth-grade boys led a score of nursery children, of ages from 2 1/2 to 4 years, from a portable into the concrete basement of the main building.

INDIA LEADER'S BROTHER JAILED

NEW DELHI, India, Thursday, Dec. 11.—(AP)—Sarat Chandra Bose was arrested in Calcutta today under defense regulations and a communique said he had been in contact with the Japanese authorities.

On to-and-from school instructions, the bulletin advises: "Should an air-raid occur on the way to and from school, children must be instructed to return home unless they have almost reached school. If they are almost to school, they should continue on the way to the building and there follow the general building instructions.

"They should avoid getting around the side of a building where flying glass might shatter around them. If caught on the sidewalk, they should lie flat on the ground near a curb or wall, if possible. The danger from bomb explosion is the throwing out of splinters and fragments in a direction parallel to the ground. By lying prone on the ground, the human body is much less of a target than if it were standing erect."

Call for air-raid drills should be a long series of intermittent bells, the bulletin suggested, and practice air-raid drills should begin at once.

Instant obedience to defense authorities, police and fire departments on traffic instructions and other advice must be observed. Pupils will be instructed not to return to school in the event of a dismissal because of an air raid. They will be expected back to school the following morning unless notified by the press and radio to the contrary.

Fort Lewis Clamps On News Censorship

FORT LEWIS, Thursday, Dec. 11.—(AP)—Army officials said today a strict program for censorship of all news emanating from Fort Lewis had been put into effect. Public relations officers of the 41st and 3rd Divisions, the post headquarters and the IX Army Corps headquarters will submit their news statements to Lieut. Col. Raymond C. Lehman, IX Army Corps military intelligence officer, who in turn will pass them on to the civilian press when approved.

A few press representatives who have passed, and who are known to Fort Lewis officials, are being allowed on the post.

Care of Pets Important In Case of Raid

Seattleites who wish to do right by their pets during air-raids should place cats in boxes or baskets, confine small dogs in the house and keep large dogs on leash.

This was the advice given today by R. W. Hinea, manager of the King County Humane Society. Hinea urged that all pets be kept off the city streets during blackouts. Dogs, in addition to license tags, should be provided with collars bearing the owners' name and address for speedier identification, he said.
