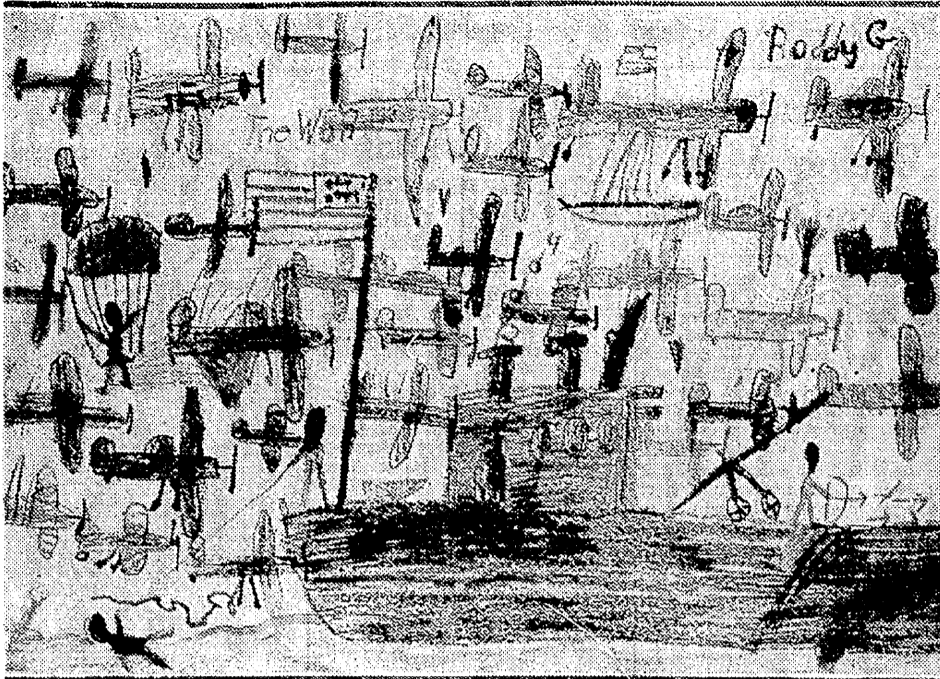
1,000 More Nazis Interned in Canada

This reproduction of a drawing shows how a 7-year-old boy visualized the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor. The artist, Roderick Guberson, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph B. Guberson, 3221 36th Ave. S., is in Grade 1-A at John Muir School. Note that one of the planes bears the Nazi Swastika and that one of the men aboard the American ship is fighting back with a bow and arrow—the arrows being shot as rapidly as machine-gun bullets. In about the center of the drawing, "Roddy" has placed the title—"The War."
