

Japs Planning Sabotage In U. S. Soon, Says Solon

WASHINGTON, March 7.—(AP)—Asserting that the Japanese "timetable" calls for the commencement of sabotage action on the West Coast about April 15, Representative Hinshaw, Republican, California, called on the administration today to "stop fiddling around" with the West Coast problem.

Unless quick action is taken to evacuate all Japanese and other enemy aliens from the West Coast, Hinshaw said in a statement, "so great a sin" may have been committed that "even history may never forgive" the administration.

The Californian said he had word that Japanese plans call for a major attack on Hawaii and West Coast sabotage next month. His information, he added, came "from a source which has been heretofore reliable, though unheeded by our government."
