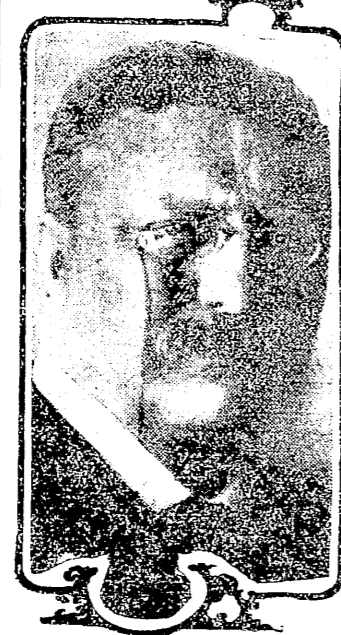
Injured Logger, Influenced by Teachings of Christian Scientists, Declines to Permit Amputation of His Leg.

The trouble has been brewing for two weeks. It broke out openly last night when the chief executive was accused of canting hypocrisy and a desire to play the game in his own way.

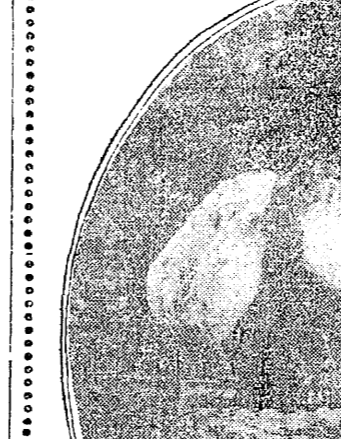
New Double Veto Work
