DR. J. A. GHENT SAYS DEATH WILL RESULT

Faith Healers of Ballard Call on John A. Gudell at Providence Hospital and Prevent Surgical Operation.

JOHN A. GUELLE, a logger, 24 years old, is slowly dying at Providence hospital because he declines to allow a badly mangled leg to be amputated, believing, according to the assertion of Dr. J. A. Ghent, his attending physician, that the prayers of certain Christian Scientists who have visited him will result in the restoration of his limb.

Dr. Ghent said today that Gudell's death may be expected almost any day, for already gangrene and mortification have set in, and within a few days he will be unable to walk, owing to the blood absorption of infectious materials. Amputation of the leg a few days ago would have saved his life, Dr. Ghent believes, but now he says that were the leg to be removed at this time the chances would be against his recovery.

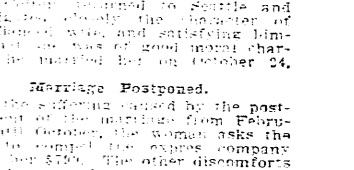
Mrs. Fred T. Deboia, wife of Idaho Senator, says children of the faith split over the American flag.



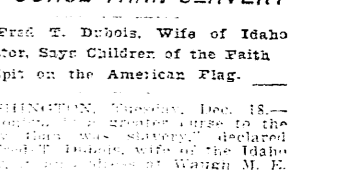
