## Pay for Evacuated Japanese Protested

LOS ANGELES, March 27.—(A)— Drastic cutting of wages to be paid Japanese evacues was demanded yesterday by a Veterans of Foreign Wars post, which asked the Presi-

dent and Congress to end the "unjustified generosity."

The post, Lincoln Heights No. 768, pointed out that evacuees' security wages, ranging from \$50 to \$94 a

month, are higher than soldiers' pay.
