

Japanese Admits Curfew Violation

After pleading guilty of violating the wartime curfew, Hideo Saiki, Japanese farmer of Bellevue, was held in the King County jail today in lieu of \$250 bail set by United States Commissioner Harry M. Westfall.

Saiki was arrested Tuesday night about 10 o'clock, near Sixth Avenue South and King Street—two hours after he was supposed to have been in his home in accordance with curfew restrictions on Japanese.
