NEW OPPOSED TO FAIRBANKS

Chairman of National Republican Committee Doesn't Favor Indianan's Candidacy for the Presidency.

Two Were Formerly in Harmony, but Trouble Arose Over Their Joint Ownership of Indianapolis Journal.

THERE IS NO question that Harry S. New, acting chairman of the Republican national committee, is opposed to the nomination of Vice-President Fairbanks for President in 1908.

In 1906, at the Philadelphia convention of the national committee on Indiana, his candidacy had the approval of Fairbanks.

Later trouble arose between Fairbanks and New over their joint ownership of The Journal.

Prior to the national convention in 1904 Fairbanks issued an order to the Republican Indiana delegation that New must not be selected as a member of the national committee.

The idea of trying to override the President's personal choice proved repulsive to the majority of the national committee, and the Fairbanks-Heneman plan failed.

It is already apparent that the Fairbanks' claims do not appeal to the President, or to his friends in the administration.

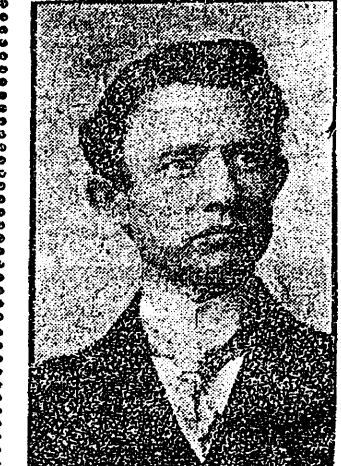

It must be remembered that I am not asking for any increase in the navy, because unless we can provide at the rate of a battleship per year our navy will go backward.

Limitation Impracticable. "In my judgment we are not excused if we build any battleship inferior to those now being built by other nations. I should be glad if a limitation could be agreed upon as to the size of battleships hereafter to be built.
