## TEAMSTERS ASK PROBE OF 'CZAR' TO JAP OUSTER

CINCINNATI, April 15.—(AP)—Gray-haired Thomas J. (Brooklyn) Farrell sought dismissal in a state court today of civil-suit charges that for 30 years he has ruled the Teamsters and Chauffeurs Joint Council No. 26, an American Federation of Labor affiliate, autocratically, and failed to account for between \$5,000,000 and \$10,000,000 of union funds.

Six of an estimated 10,000 Cincinnati area teamsters headed by Farrell yesterday sued him and 13 associates, seeking appointment of a receiver for the union, an accounting, and injunctive relief from a rule which the petition charges is maintained "with the severity of the most autocratic of dictators."

Judge Stanley Struble scheduled a hearing today on Farrell's request for dissolution of a temporary court order enjoining the defendants from (1) seeking to have the plaintiffs dismissed or laid off through "coercion directed toward their employers," (2) withdrawal of any money rightfully belonging to the local unions or their joint assets, and (3) disposal or mutilation of records, correspondence, and other personal property of the unions.

"We'll abide by any court ruling allowed by the union's constitution," said Farrell, who received no advance notice of the suit. Union books were available, he added, and "we'll do our talking in court."

The complaint, filed by J. W. Brown, local counsel for American Federation of Labor unions, and Sol Goodman, attorney, contended that Farrell had "failed to account for between \$5,000,000 and \$10,000,000" received from Joint Council No. 26 and 22 of its affiliated unions.

Farrell was sent here in 1913 by the Teamsters' International Union to act as "receiver" for the local unions "to clear up some disorder in their affairs," the petition detailed. He proceeded, it said, "to take control and completely dominate the local union" instead of "fulfilling his mission."

## Bend Has Mystery Of Dead Birds Again

BEND, Or., April 15.—(AP)—The puzzling deaths of hundreds of white-crowned sparrows occurred in Bend yesterday for the second consecutive year. The birds lay in the streets by hundreds.

When the phenomenon first occurred last spring, it was surmised the migrating birds were the victims of poisonous fertilizer. That naturalist, said he found a number of the birds had fractured skulls, suffered, he believed, by flying into wires and buildings at night.

## Balloons Drift, Causing 'Short'

Beacon Hill power lines of both City Light and the Puget Sound Power & Light Company were short-circuited when two barrage balloons broke loose from their stations and dragged cables across the power lines at Beacon Avenue and Othello Street at 3 o'clock this morning.

City Light said that power in the area was off for but a few seconds, although the supply from Cedar Falls was cut off by the short circuit. Automatic switching devices supplied power from other sources.

The Puget Sound Power & Light Company said the accident only caused lights, such as were on, to flicker before auxiliary service was supplied.

No power lines were broken by the balloons' cables. One of the balloons came to earth near Seward Park and the second last was sighted drifting northward.
