

The plans for the movement have been formulated by the naval officers who have been wrestling with the problem of dispatching the fleet to the Pacific. The President has approved the plan. Not only is there to be a powerful cruising squadron in the Pacific, but a battleship force that need fear no enemy in the world.

For General Protection. While it may be said that this move is aimed at Japan, the attitude of the government will be that it is aimed at no one in particular, but at the general protection of the American interests toward conserving Chinese integrity.

There is no question that the administration fears the movement of the fleet into the Pacific will be construed as an unfriendly act by Japan, but it fears more to leave the Pacific in a defenseless state.

Coal is to be steadily shipped to the Pacific in large quantities and dockyards will be improved. Owing to poor docking facilities in the Pacific the vessels will be overhauled here and sent on their way in the best condition.

Change in Naval Policy. It is declared on authority that the whole naval policy is to be changed, from keeping a great force in the Atlantic to concentrating it in the Pacific.

Honolulu will be the chief base for the fleet while in the Pacific. The great lesson of the Russian-Japanese war was the necessity for keeping the fleet together. The sea forces of the United States have been concentrated for the past four or five years, following the belief that in the event of war the theatre of action would be in the Atlantic.

Alignment of Powers. Emperor William and President Roosevelt were brought closely together in the peace negotiations in 1905. Germany took a leading part with this country in the peace negotiations.
