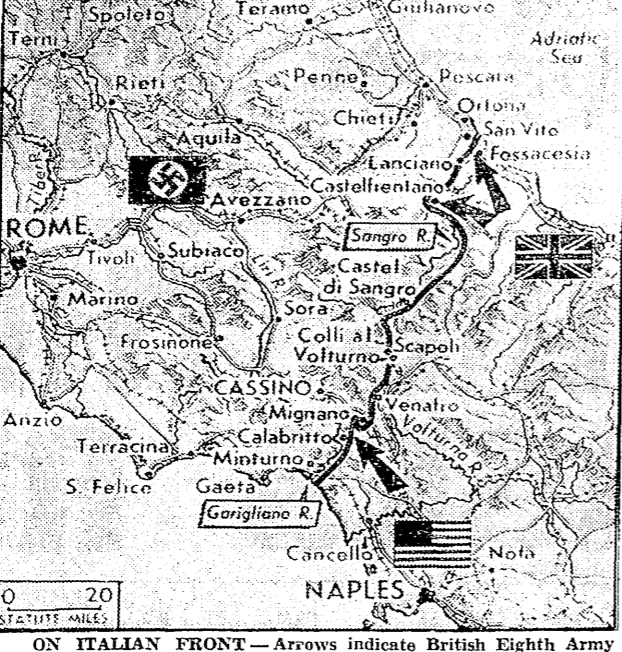

Greatest Yank Barrage Dazed Foe at Mignano

(Delayed) - Behind the mightiest artillery barrage since the British smashed Marshal Erwin Rommel's Africa Corps at El Alamein in Egypt, the Fifth Army has attacked and driven a wedge into the German so-called "winter line" at Mignano.

Relieve Pressure

The movement apparently was designed to relieve the pressure on Soviet units in the Chernassy salient, 70 miles to the north. Here numerous Nazi counter-thrusts were repulsed, according to the Soviet communique, and hundreds of Germans were killed.
